

Lake Shore and Park Lawn intersection Partial closure for rail replacement 501M, 145 and 66B bus route diversions

Dates: Friday, October 6 to Tuesday, October 10

Content/timeline accurate at time of printing

As part of this year's City/TTC Lake Shore Boulevard West track reconstruction project between Dwight Avenue and Humber Loop, the intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard West and Park Lawn Road will undergo track reconstruction starting October 6.

Track replacement

On the morning of Friday, October 6, the Lake Shore/Park Lawn intersection will be partially closed for streetcar track replacement.

- Traffic control barrels will be placed on Lake Shore through the Park Lawn intersection on the morning of Friday, October 6 to create a safe work zone. The work zone will be cleared at 6 a.m. on Tuesday, October 10.
- The work includes; concrete breaking/excavation and removal of the old track.
- New concrete and new rail installation.

Traffic restrictions

- Eastbound and westbound traffic will be maintained in the curb lanes through the intersection/work zone.
- Northbound and southbound traffic will be limited to only right-turns at the intersection.
- Street parking will be restricted within the work zone.
- Sidewalk access will be maintained.

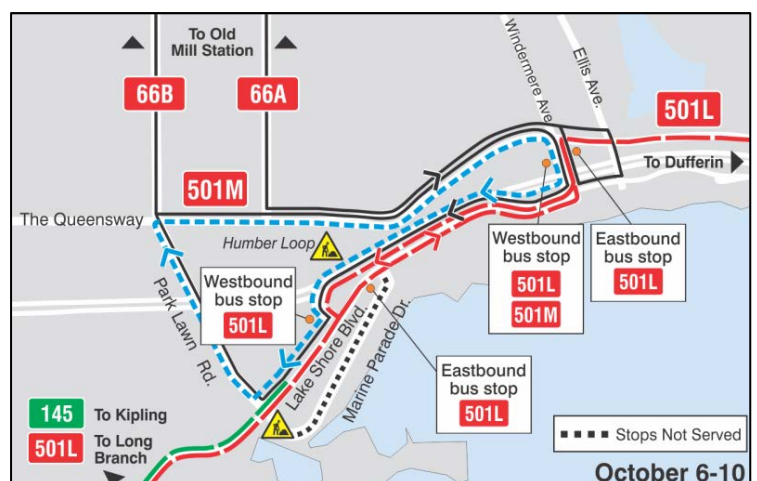
Work hours - includes overnight

Track work in the intersection will be completed on a continuous 24-hour basis. Working around-the-clock is a necessity in order to complete the intersection on schedule and re-open it to traffic/diverting TTC buses as soon as possible. The loudest work, such as breaking concrete is not expected to go past 11 p.m. Other related work such as; grading, formwork, concrete pouring/curing and new rail installation/assembly will be conducted as required and as work progresses.

TTC service (10 a.m., October 6 to 6 a.m., October 10, 2017)

During the track work at the Lake Shore and Park Lawn intersection, buses will be restricted from Marine Parade Drive and rerouted.

- **501M Queen** will operate a clockwise service linking The Queensway with Lake Shore Boulevard and Park Lawn Road.
- **145 Downtown/Humber Bay Express** buses on the westbound p.m. trips on Friday, October 6 will proceed west on Lake Shore Boulevard, through the Park Lawn Road intersection to route.
- **66B Prince Edward** buses will divert south on Prince Edward, east on The Queensway, south on Windermere Avenue, west on Lake Shore Boulevard, and north on Park Lawn Road.
