

## Lake Shore Boulevard West Near Alexander and Burlington streets Preventative track repairs

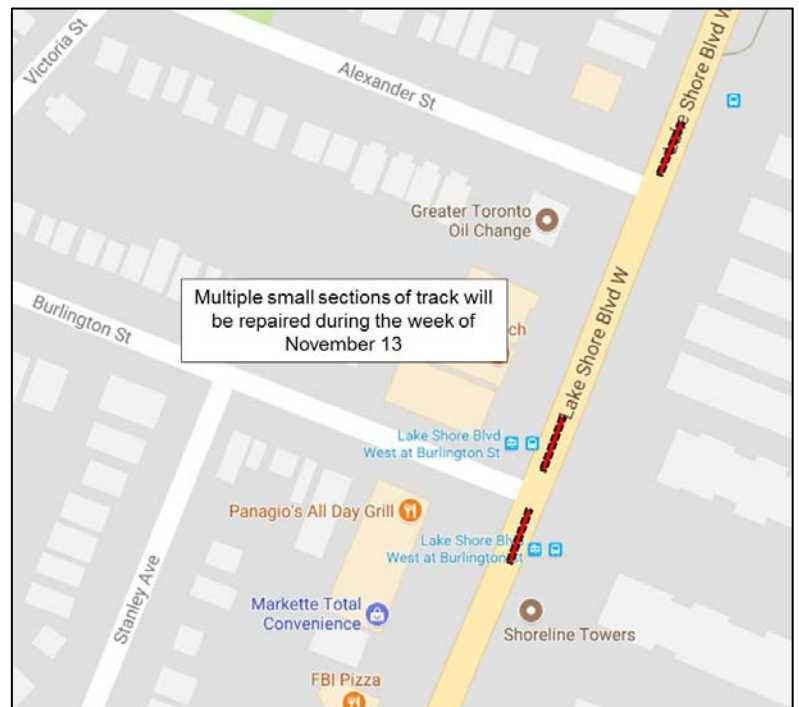

### Work description and purpose

The section of Lake Shore Boulevard West between Mimico Avenue and Alexander Street was originally scheduled for full track replacement as part of the larger Lake Shore project this year. After re-assessment of this section, track staff determined that only minor repairs are required at this time.

Starting the week of November 13, TTC will be conducting these minor/preventative repairs to a number of small track sections on Lake Shore Boulevard West near Alexander and Burlington streets. This work is required to return track areas to a state of good repair and will take approximately one week to complete, pending weather.



Work will require milling and chipping concrete to expose small sections of track for repairs.

### Traffic and pedestrian restrictions

- Crews will occupy the streetcar track allowance (centre lane) to conduct the repairs.
- Traffic will be maintained in both directions through the work areas.
- Some turning restrictions will be required to create a safe work zone for the crew.
- Some street parking may be restricted through the work areas.

### Work hours and timeline

- Work will generally take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.
- The work zone will be established around 7 a.m. on Monday and will be in place until completion.
- Activities will include milling/breaking old concrete and placing new concrete, and welding and grinding rail. New concrete will be placed afterwards and left to cure overnight.
- Lane restrictions through the work area will remain in place until work is complete.

### TTC service changes

The 501 Queen route is currently operated with buses and will be maintained through the areas.
