## LANE CLOSURES for Road Warranty Repairs on Lake Shore Blvd West from Humber Loop to Dwight Ave

Contract: 17ECS-TI-12SP

Start Date: March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

End Date: Late March 2021

*\* Timeline is heavily weather dependent and subject to change.*

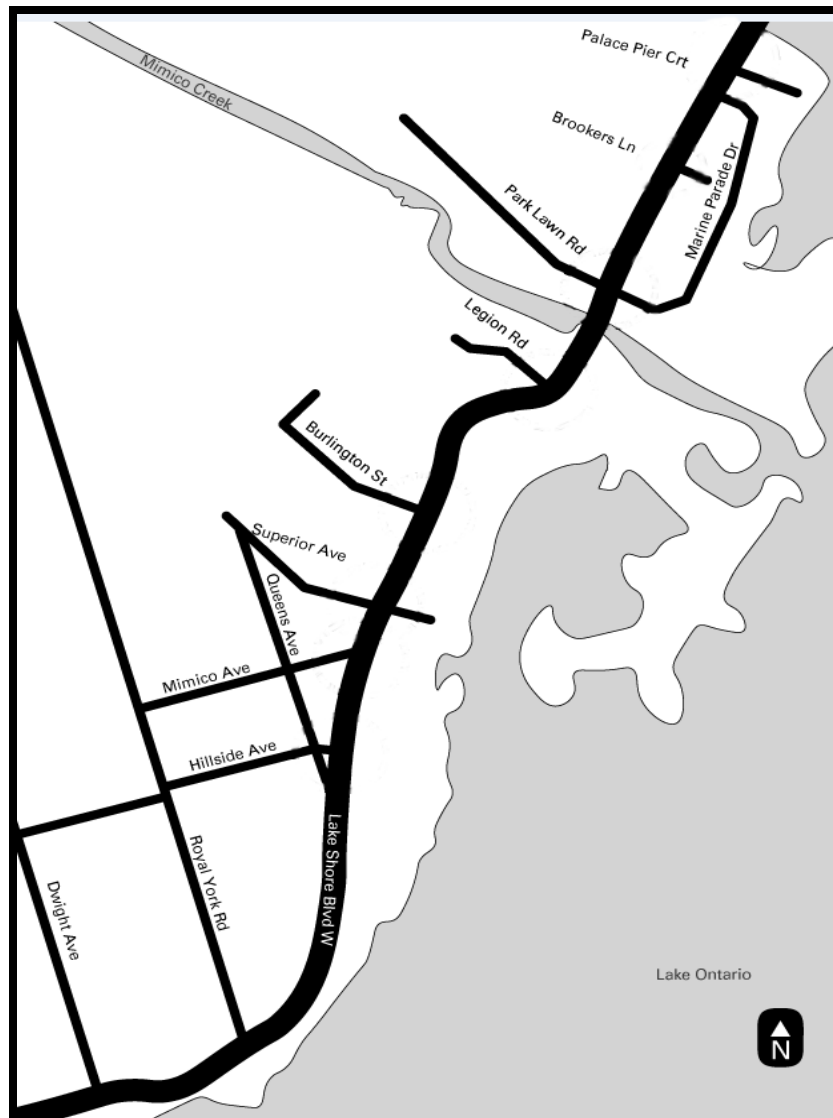
The City of Toronto will be completing warranty repair work on Lake Shore Boulevard West at various locations from Dwight Ave to Palace Pier Court. This warranty work is being completed as part of previous construction for the City. These repairs are a series of small road and streetcar track repairs. Most repair work will take place within the track allowance. Our contractor will be working at several locations along Lake Shore Blvd West resulting in daily short-term lane closures and minimal disruption to local traffic. Road advisory signage will be posted in areas where work is being undertaken.

**To accommodate this road and track repair work, there will be intermittent lane closures on Lake Shore Blvd West during March 2021.**

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO





## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from <b>7 a.m. to 7 p.m.</b> , with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road restrictions within the construction work zone. Access to all adjacent side streets and access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times during this work.
	<b>Physical Distancing:</b> There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing. If you have questions, call the contact provided on this notice.
	<b>Site Safety:</b> Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.
	<b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Due to lane restrictions, road users could experience some delays. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Intermittent lane closures on Lake Shore Blvd West during the month of March.</b></li> <li>• <b>Expect increased traffic on local roads adjacent to Lakshore Boulevard West.</b></li> </ul>
	<b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect the availability of on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call <b>416-808-2222</b> for its location.
	<b>Garbage &amp; Recycling:</b> Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <b><i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></b>
	<b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.
	<b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents that require accommodation must contact the listed Public Consultation staff to arrange for access during the construction period.
